- ✓ The Global Health (GH) Class of 2017, with 100 graduates, includes those who graduated in August 2016, December 2016 and May 2017.
- ✓ The graduation information is collected at graduation and the unemployed receive monthly follow-ups through the first-year post-graduation until employment or continuing education is secured.
- ✓ The information in this report is self-reported survey data provided by the graduate.
- ✓ Data collection for this report was completed in May 2018, at the 12<sup>th</sup> month after the May 2017 graduation.
- ✓ Information collected includes employment sector, salary range, amount of time spent job searching and number of resumes sent.

### Survey Respondents' Post-Graduation Employment Status




### International Student Status (N = 100)

This chart indicates the percentage of international student graduates from the GH department with a MPH degree.




### Years of Prior Work Experience (N = 97)

## Employment Status (N = 100)


This chart indicates the employment status of the graduates' class of 100 within 12 months post-graduation from the GH department.



The remainder of this report contains data from graduates reporting securing full-time/part-time employment. There were 69 graduates reporting securing full-time/part-time employment. Information on employer, sector, title, location and annual starting salary range was provided by 62-63 of the 69.


## Employment by Sector (N = 63)

Of the 63 reporting graduates that secured employment within 12-months post-graduation, 35% reported being employed with the government (state, local, federal) agency.



## Job Search Period (N = 62)


Within the first 4 months of starting the job search, 76% secured employment.\*



\*Many graduates begin seeking employment in the months prior to graduation.


## Number of Resumes Sent Out (N = 62)

During the job search period, 65% of graduates sent out no more than 25 resumes (average job search period is shown in the graph above).



### Salary Range of Employed Graduates (N = 63)

The median starting annual salary range reported by GH graduates securing full-time/part-time employment is \$50,000 - \$59,999.



The region in which the 62 graduates reported being employed within 12-months post-graduation, along with percentage of employed graduates in the regions are represented below.


