The 90 min Part 2 session will be announced soon and will take place during the 2023 National Public Health Week (early April). Stay tuned!

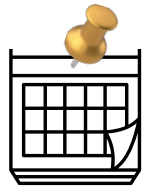
ARC RESOURCES
