- (1) Full fall/spring semester rate and hourly rate are based on 12 hours. Full summer semester rate and hourly rate are based on 16 hours.
  - (2) For summer 2020, \$1,375 is the hourly rate. Students who are only enrolled in Emory College Online Summer School courses are exempt from the assessment of the athletic fee and the mental health and counseling fee for summer term.
  - (3) The Emory Pre-College Program credit courses earn 3 to 4 credit hours each. Students in this program have the option of enrolling in one course or two. Tuition rates are equivalent to the Emory College Programs summer hourly rate.
  - (4) FY2020-21 tuition rates are subject to change upon further review of market conditions within these programs.
  - (5) Full fall/spring semester rate and hourly rate are based on 9 hours. Full summer semester rate and hourly rate are based on 9 hours.
  - (6) New students begin this program in the summer term. Entering students beginning this program in summer 2020 will be charged a \$33,550 semester rate. The rate for summer 2021 will be approved and published with FY2021-22 rates in February, 2021.
  - (7) The Evening MBA Program rates have changed from a tiered rate structure to a per credit hour billing rate. Beginning in FY2017-18, students are charged an hourly rate. However, continuing students who began the program prior to FY2017-18 will remain on the Evening MBA Program tiered structure and are charged a semester rate based on the number of enrolled hours: 0-1.0 credit hours \$1,393; 1.1-2.9 credit hours \$2,786; 3.0-5.9 credit hours \$4,700; 6.0-8.9 credit hours \$9,400; 9.0-11.9 credit hours \$14,100; 12.0-14.9 credit hours \$18,800; > or = 15 hours \$23,500.
  - (8) New students begin this program during the summer. Entering students beginning this program in 2020 will be charged a \$1,025 flat rate for the non-credit Bootcamp and a \$2,680 per credit hour rate for credit courses. The rates for 2021 will be approved and published with FY2021-22 rates in February, 2021.
  - (9) MCL students participate in a joint degree program designed to introduce them to the American Legal System. Some of their required credits are earned at Emory Law's partner institution, while most are earned at Emory Law. MCL students spend more than a semester at Emory Law, and upon completion of the program receive the MCL degree from Emory Law.
  - (10) These international baccalaureate students in law will be attending Emory Law for one semester as part of their requirements to earn their international law degree.
  - (11) Students enrolled in this program are charged tuition and University and School of Medicine mandatory fees only during the fall and spring semesters, even if they enroll in the summer semester. Students in this program are not assessed any charges in summer semesters.
  - (12) Medical students have the option to enroll for an additional year beyond the standard 4 year enrollment, but will not be assessed tuition for that year. However, University and School of Medicine mandatory fees still apply for the fall and spring semesters.
  - (13) Full semester rate and hourly rate are based on 9 credit hours.
  - (14) Full semester rate and hourly rate are based on 12 credit hours.
  - (15) Students will be charged a credit hour rate based on the number of enrolled hours.
  - (16) Students will be charged one time per semester. Students may enroll in a maximum of two clinical rotations in a one-semester period.
  - (17) This charge is applicable to international collaborative medical school students involved in Emory research for two years. The rate is assessed only for the fall and spring semesters, even if they enroll in the summer semester. Students in this program are not assessed any charges in summer semesters.
  - (18) Students will be charged \$3,600 for each 4 week elective clinical rotation.
  - (19) All students in the traditional, accelerated, or dual degree program plans are responsible for the total tuition of their program (semesters x semester rate). During summer semesters, the PART TIME MPH/MSPH rate applies when students take additional coursework above and beyond the 2, 3 or 4 semester program plans and/or enroll in 8 credit hours or less.
  - (20) Executive MPH program will offer a fixed fee rate for students who enroll in a 6 semester program taking at least 6 credit hours per semester. Students who cannot commit to 6 credits per semester will enroll part-time and pay the credit hour rate.
  - (21) Students enrolled in 8 credit hours or less will be charged at the per credit hour rate. Students enrolled in 9 credit hours or more will shift to the Traditional Program full-time charge.
  - (22) These students will not be charged any Athletic Fees, Activity Fees, or General Fees from the University or the School of Medicine.
  - (23) This would include Post-Does, Trainees, Fellows, Participants, and Scholars on F, K, and T grants who are required to take the Responsible Conduct of Research ethics training course.
  - (24) These students will not be charged Athletic Fees, Activity Fees, Student Mental Health and Counseling Fees or Technology Fees from the School of Nursing.
  - (25) The Weekend Executive MBA Program and the Modular Executive MBA Program are being merged into this new Executive MBA Program beginning FY2020-21.
  - (26) The Weekend Executive MBA Program and the Modular Executive MBA Program are being merged into a new Executive MBA Program beginning FY2020-21. No new students are being accepted in these former programs.
  - (27) Graduate MN program is new in FY21.
  - (28) The InEmory MSN program is only applicable to those students who graduated from the InEmory BSN. The Annual Cost of the program supports 9 credits over the course of 12 months. Any additional credits taken will be assessed a per credit fee of \$833.
  - (29) Graduate MN + MSN is replacing the undergraduate AMSN starting in May 2021.
