This reading list was developed by the NIA-funded U24 <u>Community Care Network for Dementia</u> (CaN-D). This reading list can help get you up to speed quickly on previously published home- and community-based services research, focusing when possible, on dementia. Inclusion Criteria

This list was generated by searching for HCBS and dementia measurement terms in Google, Google Scholar, and PubMed. The search was conducted between September-December 2023. Inclusion criteria included: articles, reports, grey literature, dashboards in English, published in the last 15 years (2008-2023), HCBS in the United States.
