12Twenty is the platform the RSPH utilizes for students to complete Graduate Outcomes and Exit Survey. The platform is open to students just before graduation and data is collected at graduation through the first year post-graduation. This data allows the RSPH to report accurate data in terms of employment, employment sectors, salary, value of education and more as required by the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH) for continuous accreditation of RSPH degrees/programs.

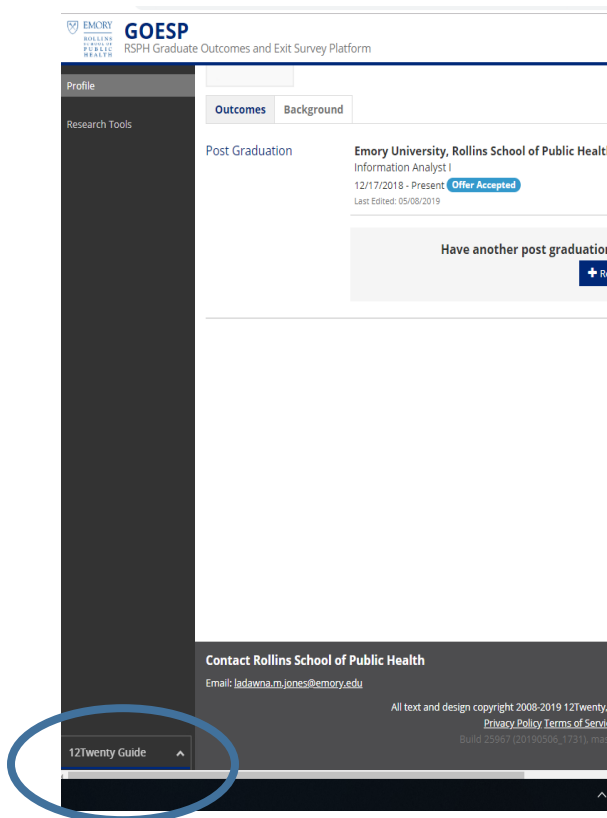
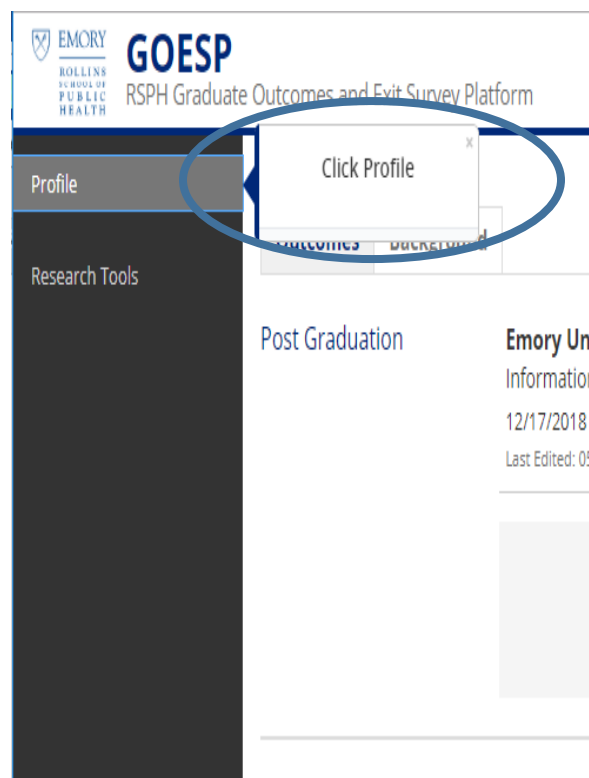
