BA/BS - MSPH Program in Biostatistics

<u>Instructions:</u> This application is <u>only</u> for the BA/BS -MSPH program in Biostatistics. Applicants to this program must be nominated by a faculty member in the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science and must have at least a 3.2 cumulative GPA at the time of submitting your application. To continue in the Rollins School of Public Health following graduation from Emory College, students must have earned and received a "B" average in all public health coursework taken. <u>Applicants must attach</u> the letter of nomination from the department, an additional letter of recommendation, one unofficial <u>Emory transcript</u>, and a one page statement of purpose explaining their academic interests and rationale for entering the program.

The application is normally submitted in the spring semester of the third (junior) year no later than February 1st. Applications will be accepted later but the deadline will enable the RSPH to inform applicants of their admission status before pre-registration occurs for the following fall semester.

Students must complete the baccalaureate program prior to matriculating into the MSPH program.
