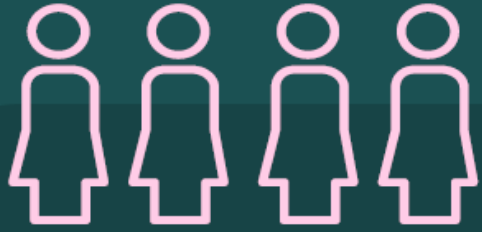


# Drivers of racial, regional and socioeconomic disparities in late-stage breast cancer
