When to use I or IP:

- **In Progress (IP) grades** - When a course, seminar, or research activity is intended to last more than one semester. The IP notation is usually only given for ILE and/or APE.
- **Incomplete (I) grades** - When more than 75% of coursework is completed toward a course or a seminar. A Resolution of Incomplete Form is required prior to posting in Incomplete Grade.

Course Withdrawal:

Students may withdraw until the last day of the class session (Regular term: 04/29/24).

A student may receive a grade of WF (withdrawal fail) if 75% of more of graded work is past due and the student is failing.

Grading Deadlines:

There are different deadlines for LGS (700-level courses) and RSPH courses (500-level courses). **Please see the grading dates below.**
