




# Hubert Department of Global Health Graduate Report




#### **Employment Status (N = 94)**

This chart indicates the status of the graduated class of 94.




#### Employment by Sector (N = 74)

Among the 94 graduates, 74 (79%) reported that they are employed and provided information regarding their employment sector.




#### Job Search Period (N = 74)

Among the 74 employed graduates who provided information regarding the time taken to find employment, 81% found employment within the first 4 months of beginning their job search.




#### Number of Resumes Sent Out (N = 74)


#### Median Salary Range by Employment Sector (N = 74)
