






### **Survey Respondents' Post-Graduation Employment Status**


Of the 81 graduates, 75 provided their post-graduation employment status through the completion of the Graduate Information Survey.\*


#### Employment Status (N = 81)

This chart indicates the status of the graduated class of 81.




#### Employment by Sector (N = 60)

Among the 81 graduates, 60 (74%) reported that they are employed and provided information regarding their employment sector.




#### Job Search Period (N = 60)

Among the 60 employed graduates who provided information regarding the time taken to find employment, 77% found employment within the first 4 months of beginning their job search.




#### Number of Resumes Sent Out (N = 60)


#### Median Salary Range by Employment Sector (N = 60)
