




International Student Status (N = 89)

This chart indicates the percentage of international student graduates from the BSHE department with a MPH degree.




Years of Prior Work Experience (N = 88)

Employment Status (N = 89)


This chart indicates the employment status of the graduated class of 89 within 11-months post-graduation from the BSHE department.


Employment by Sector (N = 59)

Of the 59 reporting graduates that secured employment within 11-months post-graduation, 41% reported being employed with the government (state, local, federal) agency.




Job Search Period (N = 59)

Within the first 4 months of starting the job search, 83% secured employment.*




Number of Resumes Sent Out (N = 59)


