

- ✓ The Behavioral Sciences & Health Education (BSHE) Class of 2017, with 74 graduates, includes those who graduated in August 2016, December 2016 and May 2017.
- ✓ The graduation information is collected at graduation and the unemployed receive monthly follow-ups through the first-year post-graduation until employment or continuing education is secured.
- ✓ The information in this report is self-reported survey data provided by the graduate.
- ✓ Data collection for this report was completed in May 2018, at the 12<sup>th</sup> month after the May 2017 graduation.
- ✓ Information collected includes employment sector, salary range, amount of time spent job searching and number of resumes sent.


#### **Survey Respondents' Post-Graduation Employment Status**



#### International Student Status (N = 74)




#### Years of Prior Work Experience (N = 74)

#### **Employment Status** (N = 74)


This chart indicates the employment status of the graduates' class of 74 within 12 months post-graduation from the BSHE department.



The remainder of this report contains data from graduates reporting securing full-time/part-time employment. There were 59 graduates reporting securing full-time/part-time employment. Information on employer, sector, title, location and annual starting salary range was provided by 47-50 of the 59.


#### Employment by Sector (N = 50)

Of the 50 reporting graduates that secured employment within 12-months post-graduation, 32% reported being employed with the government (state, local, federal) agency.



#### Job Search Period (N = 49)


Within the first 4 months of starting the job search, 78% secured employment.\*


#### Number of Resumes Sent Out (N = 49)

The median starting annual salary range reported by BSHE graduates securing full-time/part-time employment is \$50,000 - \$59,999



The region in which the 47 graduates reported being employed within 12-months post-graduation, along with percentage of employed graduates in the regions are represented below.




