- The Global Health (GH) Class of 2017, with 100 graduates, includes those who graduated in August 2016, December 2016 and May 2017.
- ✓ The graduation information is collected at graduation and the unemployed receive monthly follow-ups through the first-year post-graduation until employment or continuing education is secured.
- ✓ The information in this report is self-reported survey data provided by the graduate.
- Data collection for this report was completed in May 2018, at the 12<sup>th</sup> month after the May 2017 graduation.
- ✓ Information collected includes employment sector, salary range, amount of time spent job searching and number of resumes sent.

#### **Survey Respondents' Post-Graduation Employment Status**






#### **International Student Status (N = 100)**



### Years of Prior Work Experience (N = 97)


Upon enrolling in the MPH program at the RSPH, 23% of GH graduates reported having at least 2 years of prior work (public health and non-public health) experience.






## **Employment Status (N = 100)**

This chart indicates the employment status of the graduates' class of 100 within 12 months postgraduation from the GH department.




## **Employment by Sector** (N = 63)

## **Job Search Period** (N = 62)




Within the first 4 months of starting the job search, 76% secured employment.\*

#### Number of Resumes Sent Out (N = 62)


During the job search period, 65% of graduates sent out no more than 25 resumes (average job search period is shown in the graph above).

The median starting annual salary range reported by GH graduates securing full-time/part-time employment is \$50,000 - \$59,999.





The region in which the 62 graduates reported being employed within 12-months post-graduation, along with percentage of employed graduates in the regions are represented below.




