- ✓ The information in this report is self-reported survey data provided by the graduate.
- ✓ Data collection for this report was completed in May 2018, at the 12<sup>th</sup> month after the May 2017 graduation.
- ✓ Information collected includes employment sector, salary range, amount of time spent job searching and number of resumes sent.

## **Survey Respondents' Post-Graduation Employment Status**






#### **International Student Status (N = 92)**



## Years of Prior Work Experience (N = 91)


Upon enrolling in the MPH/MSPH program at the RSPH, 30% of HPM graduates reported having 0 years of prior work (public health and non-public health) experience.





#### **Employment Status (N = 92)**


This chart indicates the employment status of the graduate class of 92 within 12 months post-graduation from the HPM department.



The remainder of this report contains data from graduates reporting securing full-time/part-time employment. There were 70 graduates reporting securing full-time/part-time employment. Information on employer, sector, title, location and annual starting salary range was provided by 58-60 of the 70.

#### **Employment by Sector (N = 60)**

Of the 60 reporting graduates that secured employment within 12-months post-graduation, 35% reported securing employment with a hospital or health care facility.



#### **Job Search Period** (N = 60)


Within the first 4 months of starting the job search, 68% secured employment.\*

#### Number of Resumes Sent Out (N = 60)


During the job search period, 48% of graduates sent out no more than 25 resumes (average job search period is shown in the graph above).

The median starting annual salary range reported by HPM graduates securing full-time/part-time employment is \$50,000 - \$59,999.





The region in which the 60 graduates reported being employed within 12-months post-graduation, along with percentage of employed graduates in the regions are represented below.


