- ✓ Data collection for this report was completed in May 2019, at the 12th month after the May 2018 graduation.
- ✓ Information collected includes employment sector, salary range, amount of time spent job searching, and number of resumes sent.




International Student Status

Employment Status


This chart indicates the employment status of the graduate class of 95 within 12 months post-graduation.



The remainder of this report contains data from graduates that reported securing full-time/part-time employment. There were a total of 73 graduates that reported securing full-time/part-time employment.


Employment by Sector

Of the 73 reporting graduates that secured employment within 12-months post-graduation, 33% reported being employed with a government (state, local, federal) agency.



Salary Range of Employed Graduates

The median starting annual salary range reported by graduates securing full-time/part-time employment is \$50,000 - \$59,999. The salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as a full-time volunteer, i.e. U.S. Peace Corps, AmeriCorps, etc., which offer a stipend and full-time experience, but not a salary.






