$\checkmark$ The Department of Health Policy and Management (HPM) class of 2018, with 96 graduates, includes those who graduated in August 2017, December 2017 and May 2018.
$\checkmark$ The graduate outcomes information was collected at graduation and the unemployed received monthly follow-ups through the first year post-graduation until employment or continuing education was secured.
$\checkmark$ The information in this report was self-reported survey data provided by the graduate.
$\checkmark$ Data collection for this report was completed in May 2019, at the $12^{\text {th }}$ month after the May 2018 graduation.
$\checkmark$ Information collected includes employment sector, salary range, amount of time spent job searching, and number of resumes sent.

## Employment Status

This chart indicates the employment status of the graduate class of 96 within 12 months postgraduation.


The remainder of this report contains data from graduates that reported securing full-time/part-time employment. There were a total of 63 graduates that reported securing full-time/part-time employment.

## Employment by Sector

Of the 63 reporting graduates that secured employment within 12-months post-graduation, $16 \%$ reported being employed with the government (state, local, federal) agency.


## Salary Range of Employed Graduates

The median starting annual salary range reported by graduates securing full-time/part-time employment is $\$ 50,000-\$ 59,999$. The salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as a full-time volunteer, i.e. U.S. Peace Corps, AmeriCorps, etc., which offer a stipend and full-time experience, but not a salary.
