## PROCEDURE FOR APPROVAL OF A DIRECTED STUDY

A student may enroll in a maximum of three (3) hours per course of Directed Study coursework. The following procedures and conditions are required for approval.

- 1. Consult with the ADAP in completing the Proposal for Directed Study
  - A Proposal for Directed Study Form can be found on the Enrollment Services website: https://sph.emory.edu/rollins-life/documents/directedstudy10 11.pdf
- 2. Obtain the approval and signature on the proposal form from the Directed Study instructor and Chair/Director and submit to the ADAP
  - The Department Chair/Director may approve up to three (3) credit hours of Directed Study
  - Proposals for Directed Study which are more than three (3) credit hours of academic credit, require approval from the Executive Associate Dean of Academic Affairs
- 3. Register for the Directed Study course after receiving approval from the ADAP
  - The Proposal for Directed Study must be submitted and approved **prior** to the student's enrollment in the Directed Study course
  - Students who register for a Directed Study course without prior approval, risk not being able to have the credit applied toward their degree

## DIRECTED STUDY CREDIT HOUR LIMIT

The maximum number of total Directed Study credit hours can not exceed seven (7) hours.
