CANVAS TOOLS *By ES Team*

How can I track student activity in my Canvas Course Site? There are a couple of built-in Canvas tools for instructors interested in checking for students who are not engaged in Canvas.

- [Course Access Report](#) - Allows instructors to view a summary of a student's participation in their course.
- [New Analytics](#) - allows instructors to view student participation, grade distribution and comparison across course, section, or student for a weekly aggregate period, and download that data as a CSV file.
